Moseley CCTV Public Consultation

Moseley & Kings Heath Ward has been offered funding of up to £100,000 by Safer Birmingham Partnership to help provide a CCTV scheme in Moseley Village to improve the security for traders and visitors to the area. This funding however has to be spent by the end of March 2011. The Ward Committee agreed on 20th October 2010 that officers from the Hall Green Constituency in partnership with statutory agencies, local traders and residents groups carry out local consultation to initially find out if the community want a scheme in the Village.

The deadline to complete the consultation is 5th December and a report on the outcome will go to a special meeting of the Ward Committee on 15th December 2010.

These are the proposed sites and these would be monitored by the Council at its operation centre at 1 Lancaster Circus.

- 1. Site: Moseley Village car park in the south east corner affording a view over the entire car park.
- 2. Site: Alcester Road at Salisbury Road affording views, south towards Reddings Road, north towards Chantry Road, east towards Wake Green Road and west down Salisbury Road. To include view of Moseley Village Car Park.
- 3. Site: Alcester Road at Chantry Road, affording views south to coincide with the view from Camera Two, north towards the city, east into Woodbridge Road and west into Chantry Road.
- 4. Site: Alcester Road at Reddings Road, affording views south towards Kings Heath and north to coincide with the view from Camera Two. It would also have a view of the entrance to the Village Car Park, Post Office and those premises including licensed premises that extend south of the High Street. The Camera would help to provide consistent coverage for the Village.
- 5. Site: St Marys Row at Church Avenue, affording a view west to coincide with Camera Two, east into Wake Green Road, north in to the Church yard and church arbour, south into the pedestrian access into the Village Car park.

NOTE: These are not automatic number plate recognition cameras (ANPR) and are not part of any funding linked to that scheme.


